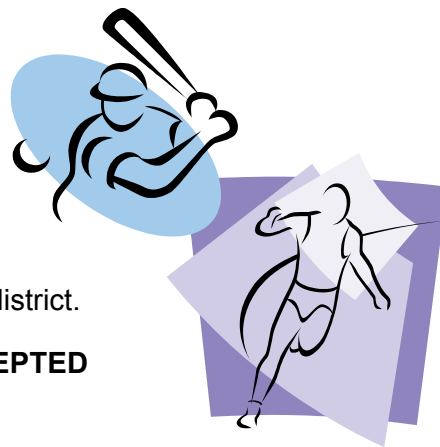
## Spring registration almost complete

# New Teener Guidelines

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## Teener 1:

- Will hold *tryouts* consisting of kids that are 14 & 15 years of age. These tryouts will be judged by a group of coaches who do not have teenagers in the program.
- Our *mission* is to put together the *best team possible*, as this division is very competitive. There will be more of an emphasis put on *winning games*, versus making sure everyone gets playing time. All games will be *WIAA rules*.
- Marshall will most likely be hosting the state tournament this year, so our plan is to put together a *team* that can *qualify for the tournament*.
- A coaching staff that has *no common interests* of anyone involved, will coach this team. This should be considered a *stepping-stone* for the *High School* baseball program. League opponents include; *Cambridge, Columbus, Deerfield, Lake Mills, & Waterloo*.
- All parents will be *required* to work in the concession stand.

## Teener 2:

- Will consist of the *remaining kids* (but primarily 14 year olds) after tryouts of the Teener 1 team.
- Team will again play in the *Teener 2 league* playing area villages such as; *Cambridge, Cottage Grove, Columbus, Deerfield, Deforest, McFarland, Monroe, Waterloo, & Windsor*.
- This level is considered *developmental*, so coaches should make every effort to *play all kids* and pitch as many as possible to ready kids for following year in Teener 1. This team may be *coached* by a group of *parents* that have teenagers on the team.
- Players from *Teener 1* team may *pitch* in the Teener 2 games to help development if they aren't pitching at the Teener 1 level.
- All parents will be *required* to work in concession stand.
